At the February Finance Meeting the 2018 Operating Budget was approved. (Copies available on the Adams Hall entry cabinet) Note this budget will be adjusted for the last part of 2018 when the new Pastor's compensation package is available.

Also discussed was the need for a focused Stewardship Drive to bring the church funds back in line with the liabilities. As mentioned before we do have a \$20,000 shortfall, even though we have been able to meet our operating budget we HAVE NOT been able to correct the cash shortfall.
